70% from Tuscany (Italy) 70% Chianti Classico.
30% from Paso Robles (California) 14% Petit Verdot, 12% Cabernet Sauvignon, 4% Cabernet Franc

VINEYARD AND TERRAIN

Passione Divina is the first wine produced by two wineries in two different countries. Azienda Agricola Campochiarenti is located in San Gimignano (Siena) Italy and Erich Russell's grapes came from the Willow Creek District of Paso Robles, California US. The Willow Creek District is the most prestigious growing region in Paso Robles. Erich has always been a master winemaker using Italian grape varietals. In fact, his 1992 Sonoma Sangiovese was named #52 on the Wine Spectator's Top 100 best wines in the world. It is Erich's love of Italian varietals that led us to Campochiarenti and the Daniele Rosti family in search of the best Tuscan Chianti to blend with his Bordeaux grapes from California.

BOTTLING:

The 2017 is the first vintage of production. It was chosen because of the high-quality level of the vintage in both countries. Each varietal was produced separately then blended just before bottling in Paso Robles, California. This wine is bigger than most Italian Chianti due to the prominent expression of Paso Robles fruit.
